



Volunteer Leader Position Information

Position Title: Cumberland River Compact Volunteer Event Leader

Position Description: Volunteer leaders will have the opportunity to work directly with volunteers on projects that have immediate and long-term impacts on the health of our environment and community. The purpose of this position is to engage, lead, and inspire volunteers to perform important conservation work in the community. Volunteer leaders will be trained on litter cleanup safety, operating procedures and volunteer management techniques. Volunteer opportunities through the Cumberland River Compact have a direct positive impact on streams and rivers in the Cumberland River Basin.

Location: Various locations around Nashville, TN

Key Responsibilities:

- Help lead volunteer events and supervise volunteers. Some examples of our volunteer opportunities include: river cleanups, rain garden planting and maintenance, tree planting and watering, depave events, and other special events.
- Review and enforce safety guidelines with volunteers during events.
- Help the CRC staff member set up/breakdown event and supplies.

Qualifications:

- 18 years of age or older.
- Access to reliable transportation.
- Strong communication and leadership skills.
- Previous volunteer experience recommended (especially with the Cumberland River Compact), but not required.

Time Commitment:

Training:

- Volunteer event (as a leader in training) - four hours
- Virtual or in-person orientation - one hour
 - Overview of Cumberland River Compact
 - Event procedures and safety guidelines

Volunteer Leader Time Commitment:

- At least four events over one year.
- Most events are hosted on Saturdays and occasionally during the week.
- Volunteer Leader shifts are four hours including 30 minutes before and after each event.
